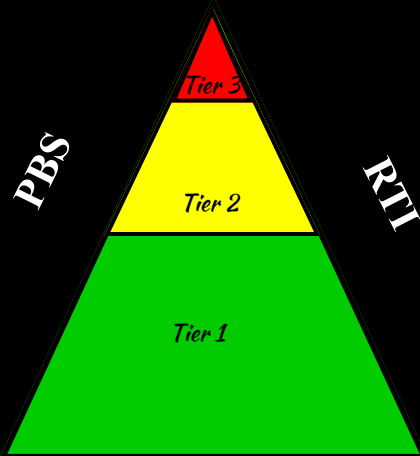

The Goals of PBS at Lewis

Overall Goal: help each child develop self-discipline while maintaining a safe learning environment



Shared responsibility of home and school working together to develop good citizens by recognizing positive contributions of students



Teachers, administrators, counselors, and support staff are going to take responsibility to TEACH positive behavior expectations to students.



Students will know exactly what is expected of them.



Students who take responsibility to behave positively will be recognized and rewarded in a variety of ways. Students also know exactly what consequences will result when they choose NOT to meet the school wide expectations.
